Killiney Community Hall Building Site**

NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO VOLUNTEER AS A SCRUTINEER

On Saturday, November 19, 2011 qualified electors within the Killiney Community Hall Service Area will be voting on the following question:

“Are you in favour of the Regional District of Central Okanagan adopting Bylaw No. 1294 to establish a service area within a portion of Central Okanagan West Electoral Area to operate and maintain the Killiney Community Hall, at an annual cost not to exceed \$0.05 per \$1000 of assessed value of land and improvements on properties within the service area?”

In accordance with Section 169 of the *Local Government Act*, Scrutineers for and against the question must be appointed if applications are received from persons **who wish to volunteer for the positions.**

Only persons entitled to vote as electors on the question shown above are entitled to act as scrutineers. One scrutineer for and one scrutineer against the question may be appointed for each voting place if sufficient applications are received.
