Remember:

2. Please abide by the leash laws & keep your dog on-leash when entering or leaving the park.
3. Please use caution in approaching people and other dogs when you are with your dog.
4. Do not leave your dog unattended at any time, including in an unenclosed vehicle.
5. Ensure your dog has plenty of water and does not become over-heated in the summer (in a car, camper or biking).
6. Please be respectful of other animals and people.
7. Ensure yard gates are secure.
