

North Westside Road and Traders Cove Recycling and Waste Transfer Station

North Westside Road Transfer Station

is operated by the Regional District of Central Okanagan. In order to use this transfer station I.D cards are required. These cards can be obtained from the site manager during hours of operation. New residents will be issued an ID card after filling in an application form. ID cards are issued annually. **Lost ID cards can be replaced at a cost of \$5.**

All services are based on bin availability and the site manager has the right to control and refuse delivery of any material brought to the transfer station site.

Hours of Operation:

Monday, Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. Closed Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Years Day.

Sugarloaf Mountain/ Whiteman Creek Forest Service Rd. 3.2 km past the fire hall on Udell Road.

Intersection of Bear Lake Main and Westside Road

Illegal Dumping

- Fines for illegal dumping to a maximum of \$2000
- If you witness illegal dumping, take note of the time, date, place, vehicle and license plate number and report to a member of the site administrator

Recycling:

An unlimited amount of recycling is accepted. It must be separated into the appropriate bins.

- Cardboard (flattened)
- Paper (includes newspaper)
- Plastics #1 to #7
- Milk jugs (flattened)
- Plastic bags (tied together)
- Tin cans

Yard Waste:

Grass cuttings, shrub and tree trimmings up to 1 m (39") long and up to 20 cm (8") in dia. to a maximum load of 250 kg, 10 bags or one pickup load. No building materials, rocks or nails please.

Garbage:

- Up to 2 bags per household per week.
- Up to 2 extra bags per week may be disposed of if labeled with Tag-a-Bag stickers.
- Tag-a-bag stickers may be purchased from the Site Manager for \$2 each and must be placed on the bags before they are disposed of.
- Can not accept business waste, glass, waxed cardboard, propane canisters, batteries, appliances, TV monitors, hazardous materials, household furniture etc. The site manager can direct you to locations accepting these items.
